However, due to the poor health of his father nearing the end of Jack's secondary education, a family decision was made for Jack to not attend university.

As such, throughout his young adulthood, Jack faced immense responsibility as he had to work tirelessly to support both him and his family. He worked many jobs, the most notable of which being in the food service industry. Unfortunately, in 2000, after 45 years of work, Jack was forced to retire due to health complications. However, this was not before he met and married Tolsa Greenberg, and started a family with two daughters. He now has 4 grandchildren, all of whom he loves very much.

Currently, Jack is retired, but he is still actively involved in the community.
