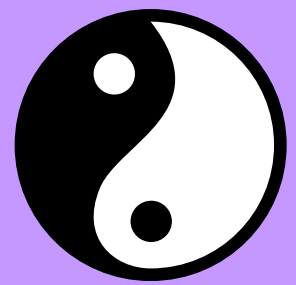


# MOON-JA PARK: A Life At A Glance



**April 22, 1942**

Moon-Ja is born in Busan, South Korea to Mal-Sook and Duck Rae.



**1959**

Moon-Ja graduates from an all-girls high school.



**1960**

Moon-Ja gets into the prestigious Pukyong National University in Busan and attends for 4 years and a post-graduate program.

**1962**

Moon-Ja meets Young H. Park.



**December 18, 1965**

Moon-Ja and Young H. Park get married.



**1966**

Moon-Ja and her husband immigrate to Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, in the pursuit of further studies.



**1966-1968**

Moon-Ja works for the University of Manitoba Faculty of Agriculture as a Research Assistant for soil chemistry.

**1972**

Moon-Ja, along with her husband and a few others in her community, become founders of the Korean Christian Church.



## 1995

Moon-Ja becomes the National Chair and CEO of the Korean United Church Association.

## 1998

Moon-Ja attends the Racial Christian Women's Conference in Cedar Glen, Ontario, Canada.



## 2009

Moon-Ja retires, moving from Winnipeg back to South Korea with her husband.



## 2011

Moon-Ja completes her TESOL Diploma at Busan University of Foreign Studies, graduating at the top of her class and as the class valedictorian.



## 1996

Moon-Ja attends the National Christian Women's Gathering in Canada.



## 1998

Moon-Ja attends the National Christian Women's Gathering in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada and the World Council of Churches Assembly in Harare, Zimbabwe.



## 2009 - 2015

Moon-Ja teaches English at an elementary school in South Korea.



## 2016

Moon-Ja and her husband move to Toronto, Canada, to stay closer to family.
